The most important information—in this example, the status of the user story and its progress—is at the top. Links to title, tags, description, attachments, and comments are available on the left, if you want to see them. Additional details are on the right.

Everything is lined-up neatly and clearly. Relevant information is obvious, and if you need to zero in on just a few items, you can hide the others.

### **In-line Edit**

Don't you hate clicking on something you want to change, then finding you're taken to an edit screen where you make your change, verify it, and then have to navigate back to the original screen? ### **A picture's worth a thousand scrolls**

When you need to find a person to assign to a task, an alphabetical list is only helpful if you remember people's names and how to spell them. Of course if you want, you could scroll and scroll through the list until a name looks familiar, but TargetProcess's Quick Search and images take the scrolling out of Search.

People can add their own avatars, which makes them much easier to be found than by name alone. But you can still search by name, if you want. When you start typing a name—either first or last, it doesn't matter—Quick Search shows results as you type.

## Logical layout

At Company X, we use our own products, or as they say at other software companies, we eat our own dog food. We know which actions we use most, and from what you've told us, many of you use similar actions. To make it easy for you, we've put the most popular actions at the top and made them buttons.

You don't have to worry about accidentally clicking and taking a potentially dangerous action. The buttons for actions you might regret, like unassigning a person, turn red when your mouse pointer hovers over them.

## Lost in links no more

Unlike a rose (a rose is a rose is a rose), a link is not always a link to another location. It could initiate an action, such as an edit. TargetProcess takes away the confusion by clearly differentiating between directional links and action links. Links that lead to actions have a tiny icon next to them.

Links that lead to other places don't have the icon.

## Speaking of actions

Sometimes you see an empty field and want to know if you can add a value to that field. You don't have to wonder about it. Just hover your mouse pointer over the field, and TargetProcess lets you know if the field is editable.

## We don't overwhelm you

TargetProcess shows you the information you need in a clean, unencumbered interface. Information you're not using right now, but that you've stored, is still available. TargetProcess keeps it out of sight until you want it.

- TargetProcess hides old releases and iterations by default, but provides an easy way to make them visible.
